GET TO KNOW US!

The RENOVAL project is an Erasmus+ project that started on 1 October 2020 for a duration of 24 months.

The aim of the project is to support the transfer of know-how from older generations of craftsmen to new generations of apprentices and to improve the use of digital technologies in the sector by improving the digital skills of craftsmen and apprentices.

Support is provided through an intergenerational learning approach combined with the use of smart and user-friendly digital technologies.

In order to achieve these objectives, an alliance of 6 organisations representing craft sectors and adult education experts and providers are working together to design and co-create new training content and innovative digital tools for adult educators to support intergenerational learning and validation of skills in the craft sectors through digital technologies.

WHAT HAS BEEN DONE SO FAR?

In December 2020, the first project meeting with all European partners took place online. Timetable, objectives and other procedures were discussed.

The partners then met again, still online, due to the health crisis, on 06 April and 08 July for follow-up meetings of the project.

To date, the training curriculum on intergenerational learning and validation of skills in craft sectors has been developed and is now ready.


The digital gamification tool which is the second phase of the project is at this point being finalised.
